## The Central South Wales Challenge: 'By Schools, For Schools'

The Central South Wales Challenge (CSWC) is the partnership of all schools and settings across the Central South Consortium (CSC) region working together to develop a self-improving system.

The CSWC model is designed to be:

- Consistent across the region
- School led
- Informed by prior knowledge of a self-improving school system
- Focussed on providing value for money
- Responsive to the changing needs of schools.

The CSWC includes of a number of components that support the self improving school system. Each component plays a key role in ensuring that all schools and settings in the region can access appropriate professional learning and support.

Schools and settings should engage with the components and PL activities that best support their school improvement priorities.

The CSWC model and its individual components are evaluated and refined annually, ensuring the evolving needs of schools within the region and needs of the wider system and considered. All CSC professional learning activities are evaluated using the [Kirkpatrick model](#).

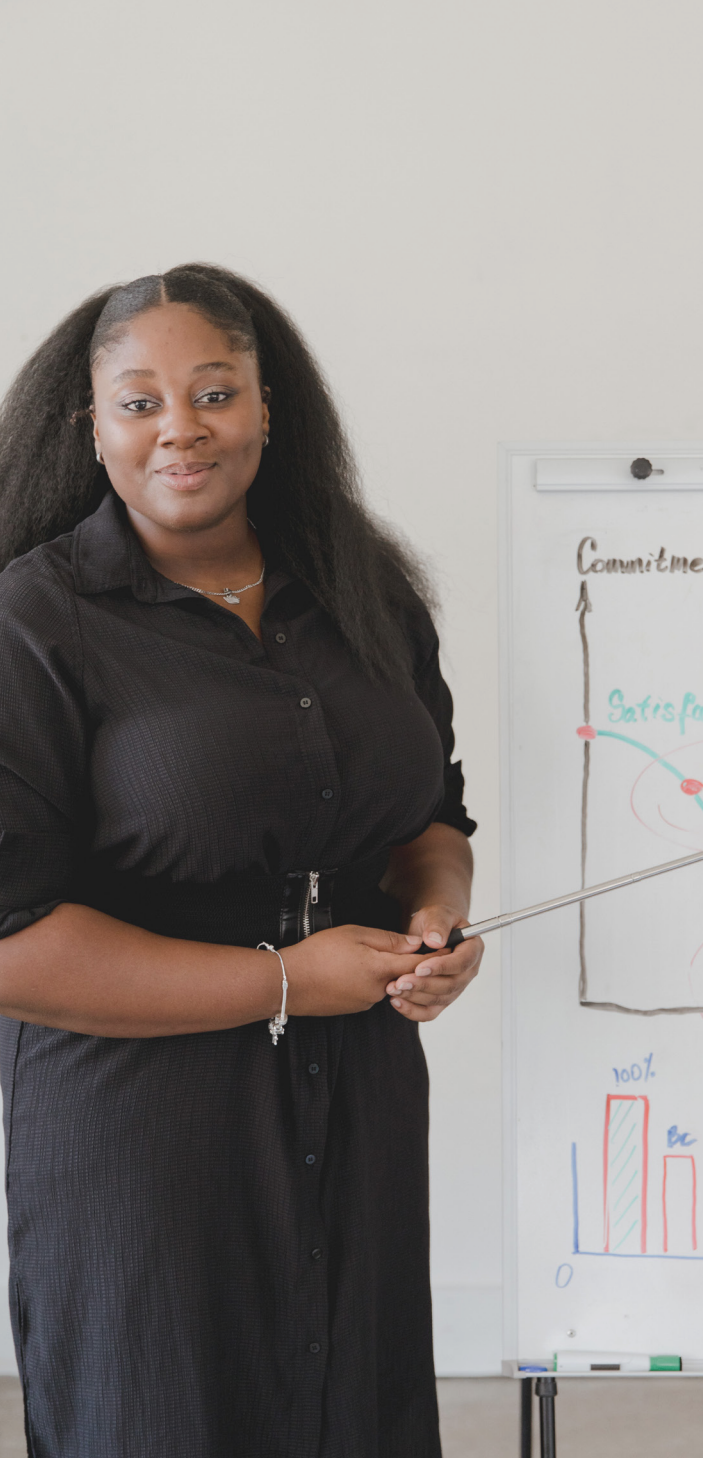
